

Quick Start: How to Enable Kaltura Videos in a Canvas course

1) In **Course Navigation**, click the **Settings** option.

2) Click **Navigation** tab.

3) Drag **My Media** button from bottom list to top list.

4) Click the **"Save"** button (bottom of page).

5) In **Course Navigation**, click the **My Media** option.

6) Once enabled, Kaltura videos will show in the **Content Pane** of your course.
