COURSES

ALS 6015: Teaching in Higher Education

This course assists graduate students in preparing for faculty positions in higher education. The course covers faculty roles and responsibilities, educational philosophies, learning theories, instructional methods, course design, and assessment, among others.

Teaching & Learning in the Diverse Classroom

June 1-30, 2021

This online course explores frameworks and strategies for building and sustaining inclusive learning environments and is open to anyone in the Cornell teaching community.

Learning Community on Inclusive Teaching

June 1-July 6, 2021

This six-week online program runs concurrently with *Teaching & Learning in the Diverse Classroom*. Participants meet weekly via Zoom to discuss ways to create and sustain inclusive learning environments. Identify practical, evidence-based strategies appropriate for your discipline and future teaching plans.
